

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

• Raise income through benefit/tax credit changes

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
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• Not necessarily spent on fuel

Inadequate clearance rates

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- Fitness standard

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- Energy Efficiency Commitment & Warm Front Team Grant Scheme – private sector
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  - 30% fuel poor not eligible
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- 30% target HECA only 10% 2001
