OUR METHODS:

SURVEY

 Recruit 500 practices spanning 3 ICBs: Birmingham and Solihull; Coventry and Warwickshire; and South Yorkshire.



- \odot Staff within any role to respond.
- Survey will take no longer than **5 minutes** to complete, and for each practice returned survey, a tree shall be planted through **NHS Forest**.
- Practices can express interest in becoming a case study.

LONGITUDINAL CASE STUDIES

- ✓ 12 practices will be followed for >9 months. Data will be collected on how they plan and implement decarbonisation actions, challenges and barriers, and how these are overcome.
- We will host a workshop, use interviews, focus groups, and the nonclinical carbon calculator to collect data. Practices will be offered **£2500** as commitment to participation.
- ✓ To understand patients' views, we will invite 35 at each participating practice to complete a survey, and some will be selected for further interview.
