

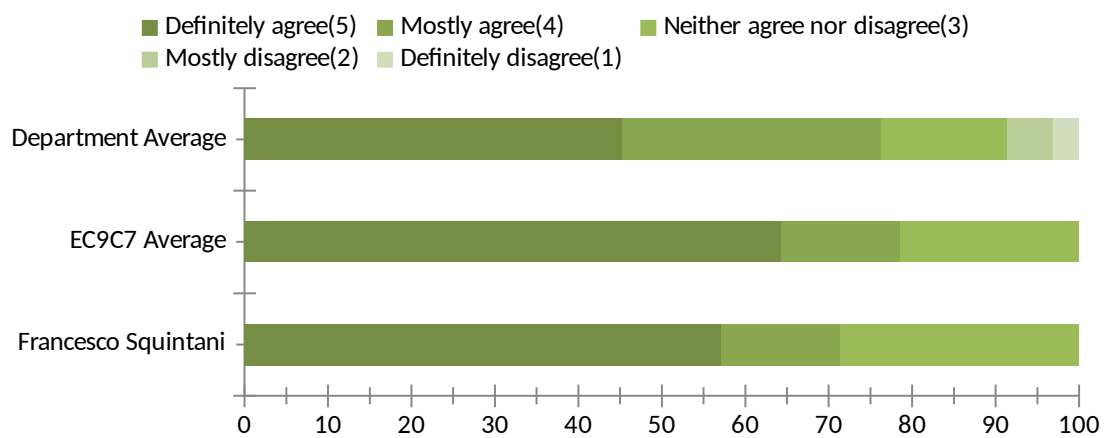
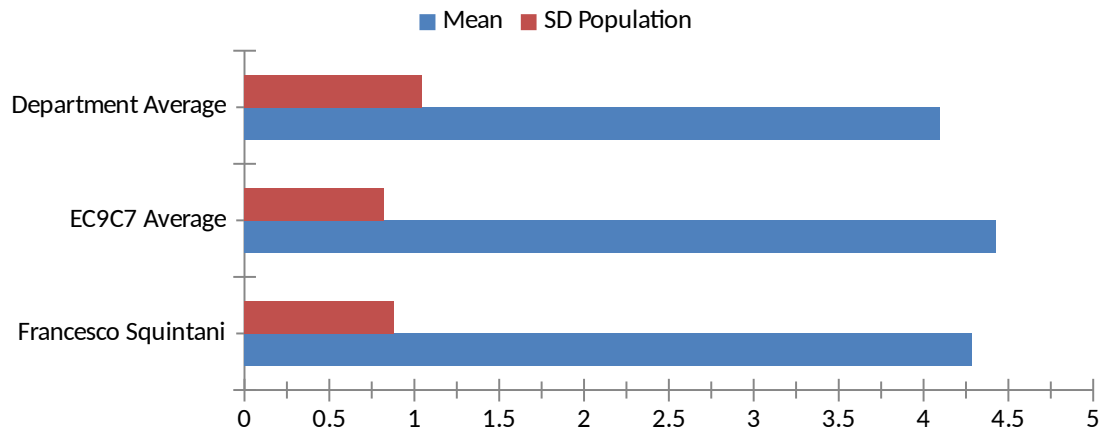

1) The lecturer is good at explaining things and has helped me to understand the subject

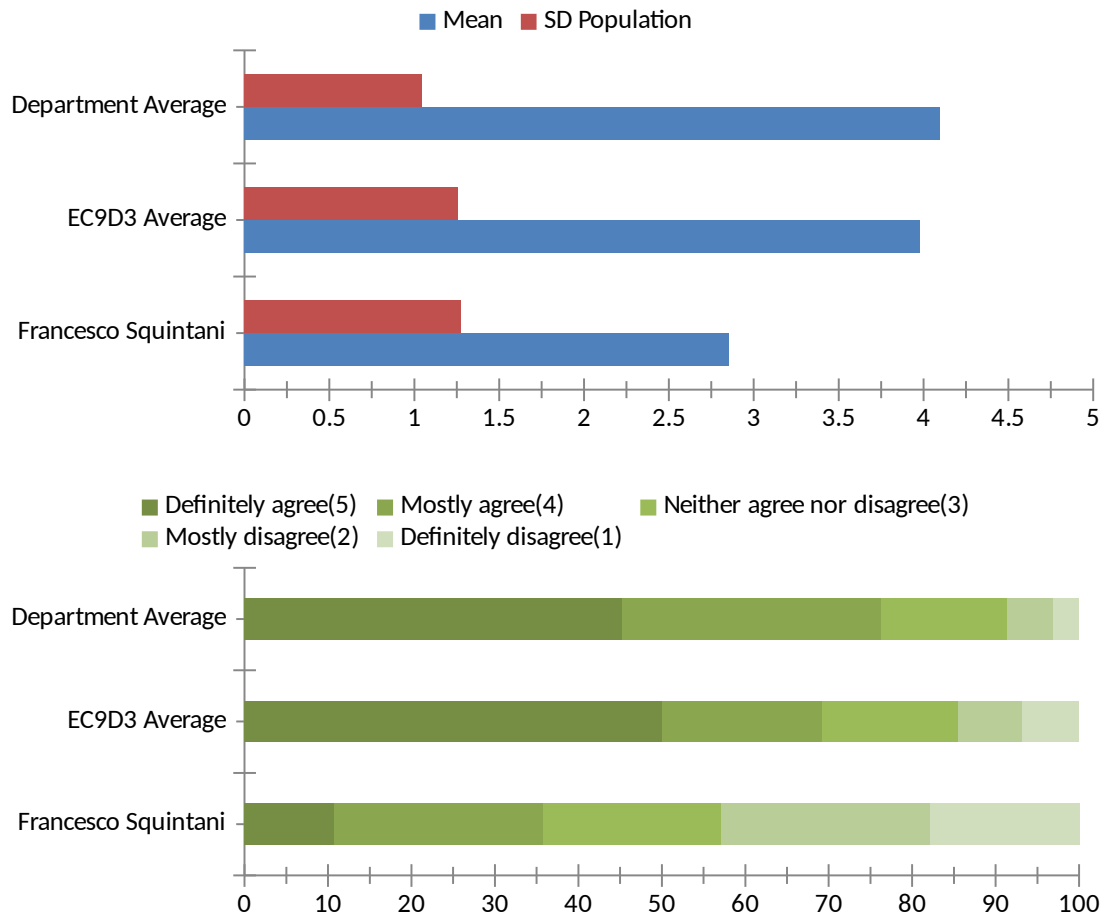
Francesco Squintani received responses from 7 individuals with a minimum rating of 3 and a maximum rating of 5.

It is not acceptable to just read the slides and not explaining properly any of the demonstrations and proofs of the course. 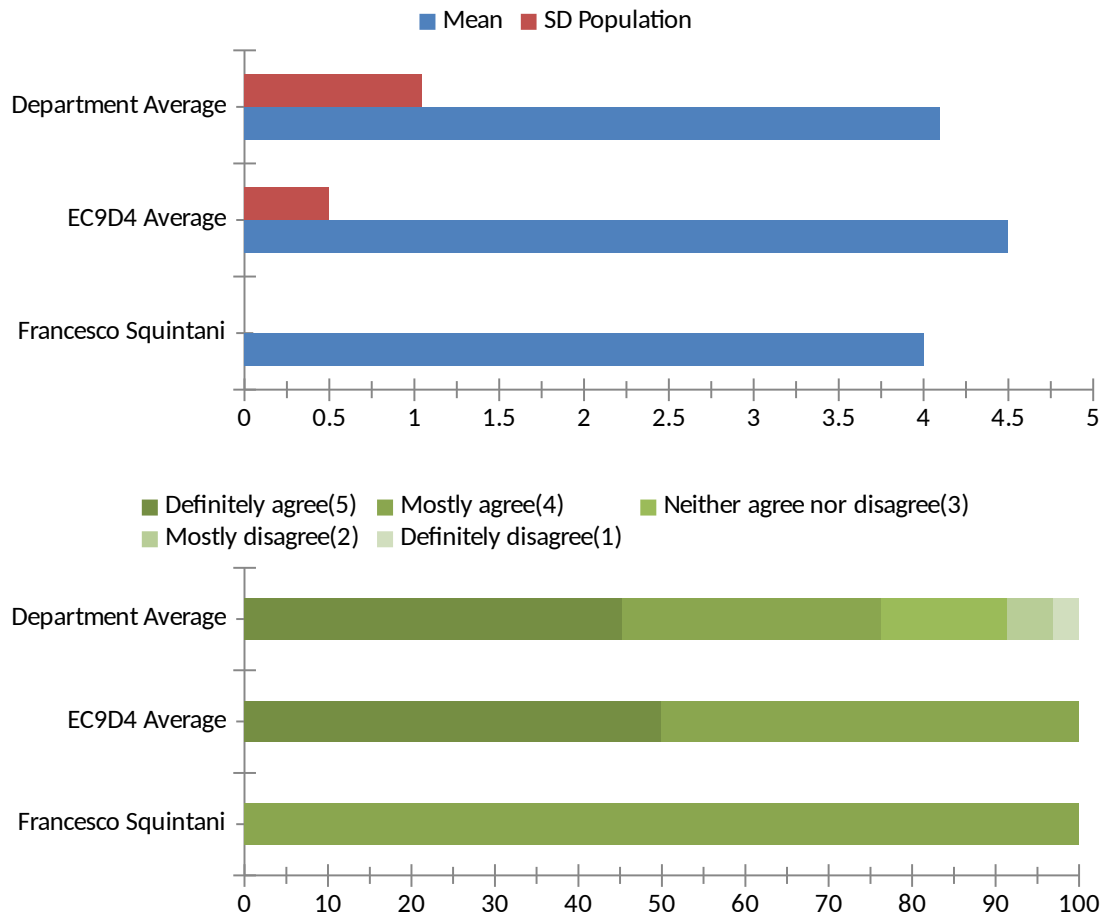
