APMOD 2014 is the eleventh conference in the series of successful events that bring together distinguished researchers and practitioners from academia and industry to exchange knowledge, ideas and results in a broad range of topics relevant to mathematical optimization, modelling languages and software, theory and practice of computational methods and solution algorithms.  - paper titles and abstracts (TEXT format; not exceeding 300 words) for each presentation;
- **Abstract Submission: 15 January 2014**
- **Notification of Acceptance: 10 February 2014**
- **Early Registration: 20 February 2014**

BEST STUDENT PAPER PRIZE

- The prize is £200 and to be awarded at the conference
- Papers should be nominated by the supervisors of the students;
- Paper authored only by the student or co-authored with one supervisor;
- Desired length: 25 A4 pages. **Submission deadline is 1 February 2014.** Only registered participant papers will be considered for the prize;
- Shortlisted candidates will be notified ahead of time and only those actually attending the conference will be considered for the prize.

- Papers presented at the conference will be considered for publication in Annals of Operations Research.
