University of Warwick Piano Competition

General Rules and Regulations

1. The University of Warwick Piano Competition is organised by the Music Centre and Warwick Piano Society and will be held on Tuesday 13th March 2012.
2. The competition is open to all staff and students who play the piano at the University.
3. Competitors are required to arrive and register 10 minutes before the time of their performance.
4. Competitors must complete an application form, which must reach the Music Centre Administrator no later than 4.30pm on Friday 9th March.
5. Repertoire must be selected from published classical or Jazz work.
6. Competitors are permitted to perform either from memory or from score.
7. The competition may be in front of an audience.
8. The decision of the jury will be final and no appeals will be allowed.
9. The jury reserve the right to stop performances which exceed the time limits.
10. Competitors will be judged on technique, style, interpretation and musicianship.
11. Only repertoire for solo piano may be performed. Works for duet and two pianos will not be accepted.
12. Competitors should adopt appropriate dress and platform manner.
13. The jury will be chaired by Paul McGrath (Director of Music). Lucy Griffiths (Assistant Director of Music) and other professional musicians.

Performance Requirements

14. Competitors must offer a programme with a minimum of 2 contrasting works. A maximum of 20 minutes performance time will be allowed.

Prizes

15. A certificate will be presented to the first, second and third prize winners, and all three will be invited perform in a lunchtime concert.
16. The cash prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be £30, £20 and £10 respectively.
