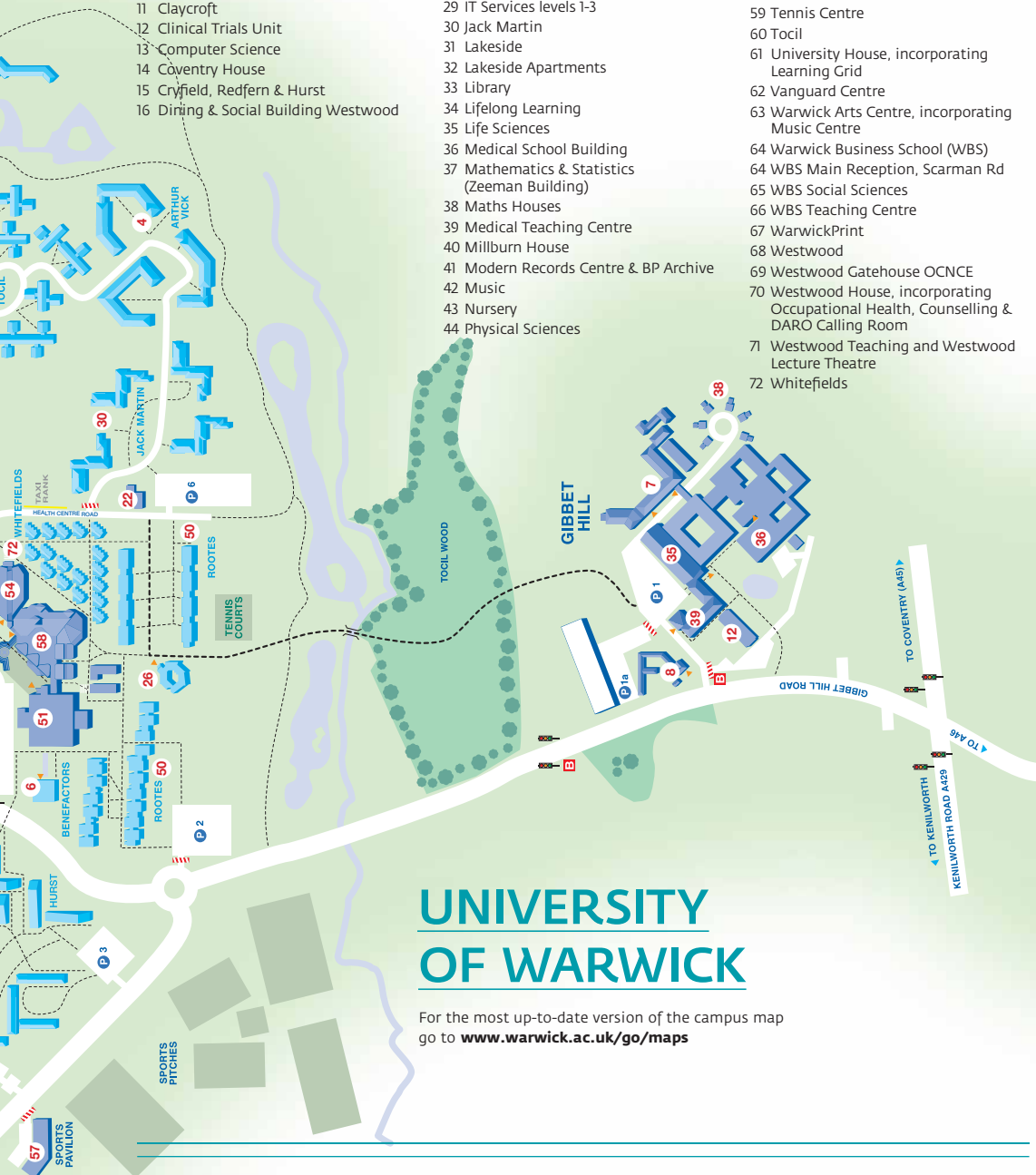

By Car

From the North

M1, M69, follow the by-pass routes marked Warwick (A46), then follow the signs to the University. Or: M6, A446, A45, then follow the signs for the University.

From the South

M1, M45, A45 or M40, A46, follow the signs to the University.

From the East

Join the M1, then follow directions as for travel from the North or the South.

From the West

M5, M42, A45, follow the signs for the University.
On campus parking (can be crowded in term time).

By Air

Nearest airports are Coventry (CVT), Birmingham International (BHX) and London Heathrow (LHR).

By Rail to Coventry

From London (Euston): 1 hour 15 mins
From Birmingham International (Airport): 11 mins.

There are frequent, regular bus services to Coventry, Kenilworth and Leamington from the campus.

Each year the University and its generous alumni make a significant investment in PhD scholarships to fund the best new doctoral researchers applying to Warwick. If you are an excellent candidate for PhD study, we invite you to join the competition for approximately 70 PhD scholarships offered in total across all disciplines to UK/EU and international applicants:

- At least **17 Chancellor's International Scholarships** paying the full overseas fees plus a maintenance stipend of £13,590 p/a for the best PhD applicants from across the world;
- Around **40 Chancellor's Scholarships** paying fees at the UK/EU rate plus a maintenance stipend of £13,590 p/a, available to both Home and International PhD applicants;
- **AHRC Doctoral awards** for Home and EU PhD applicants for the Arts and Humanities.

Applications for all of the above can be made using the single application form for admission and scholarships from 1 August 2011. In addition to the above, separate competitions operate for a variety of outstanding funding opportunities, including Warwick's new ESRC Doctoral Training Centre, EPSRC funding, and many individual project studentships.
