# About ABP

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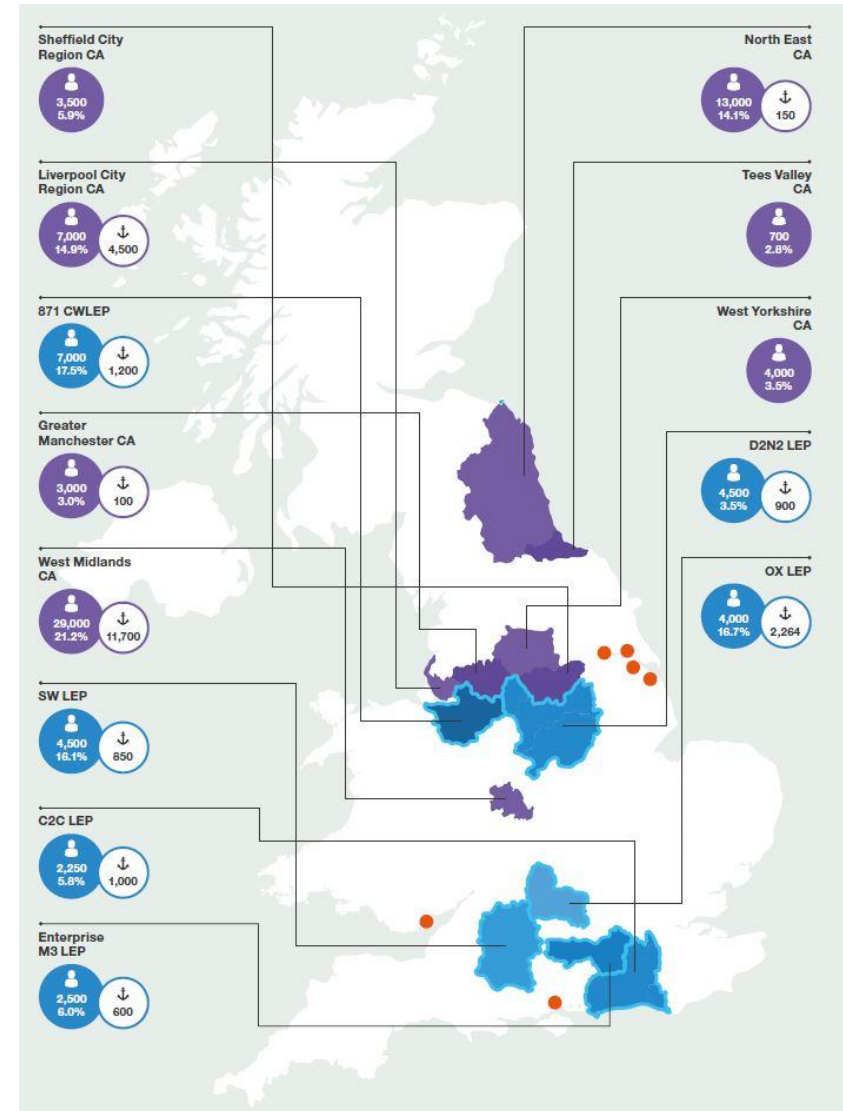
- 21 ports

## Automotive

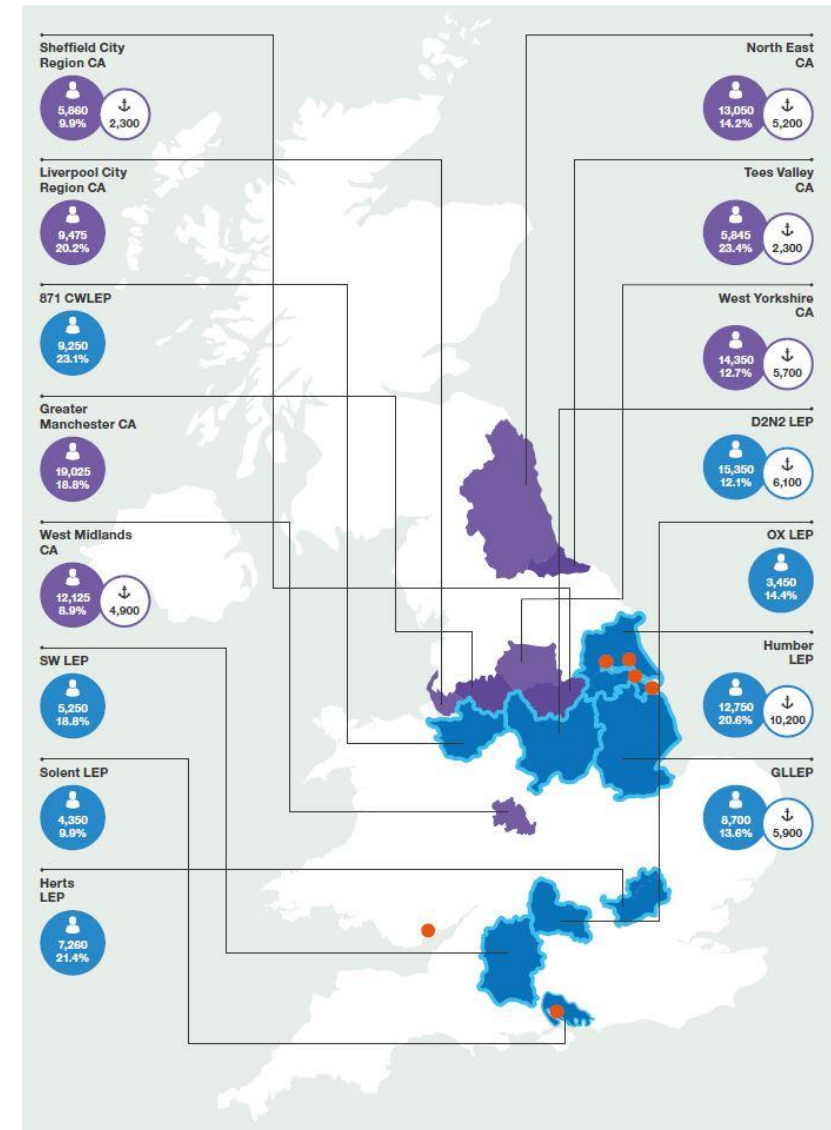
- Port of Southampton UK's number one automotive port

## Chemical, Pharma, Oil and petroleum

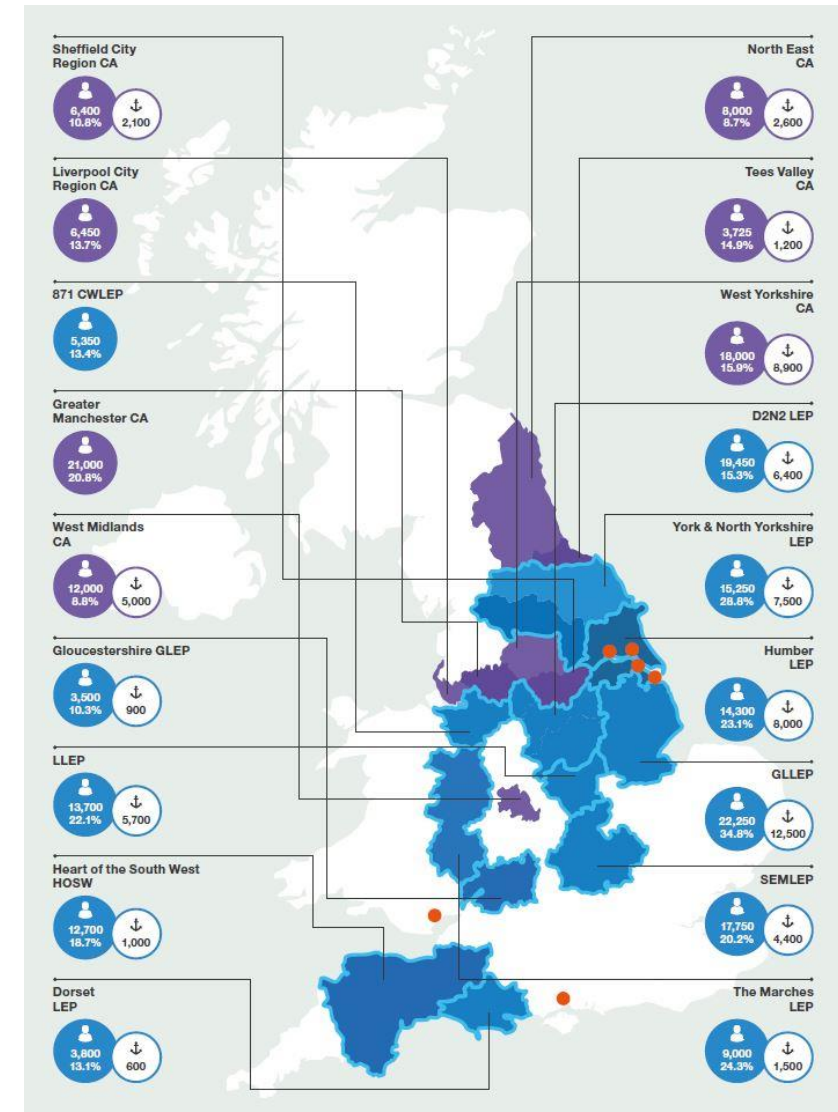
- Humber ports support 5,700 jobs in West Yorkshire

## Food and Beverages

- Humber ports support 12,500 jobs in food and beverages sector across Greater Lincolnshire



# Trade breakdown EU v WTO

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- Roughly 50/50 split between EU and WTO across the Group
- Varies substantially between ports:
  - Southampton 10% EU / 90% WTO
  - Humber ports 60% EU / 40% WTO
  - Dover 100% EU

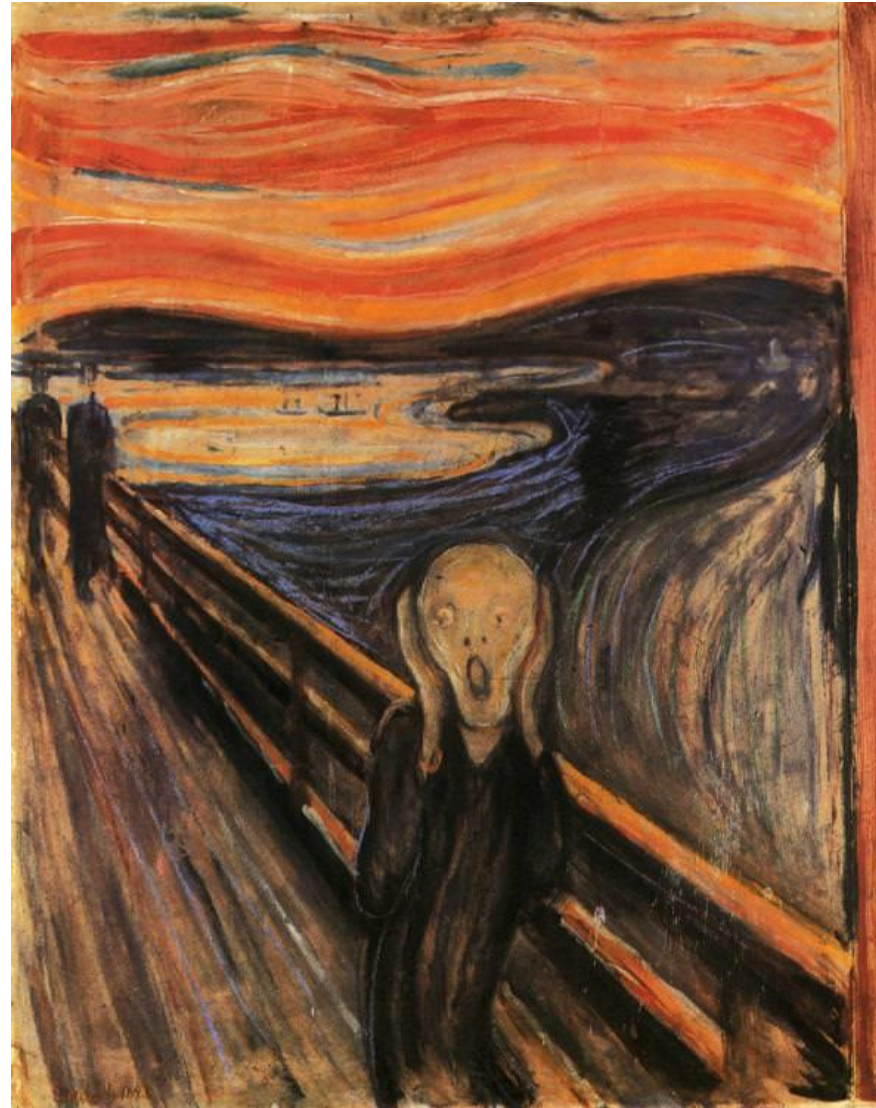
# Impact of leaving the Customs Union

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- Customs Declarations **will be** necessary

What happens under WTO Rules?

- 1.3% of cargo stopped for checks
- 80% of checks by Port Health to enforce animal and food health and safety regulations
- Only 0.25% of cargo might need to be stopped for inspection after leaving the Customs Union?
- Remote Customs Checks?
