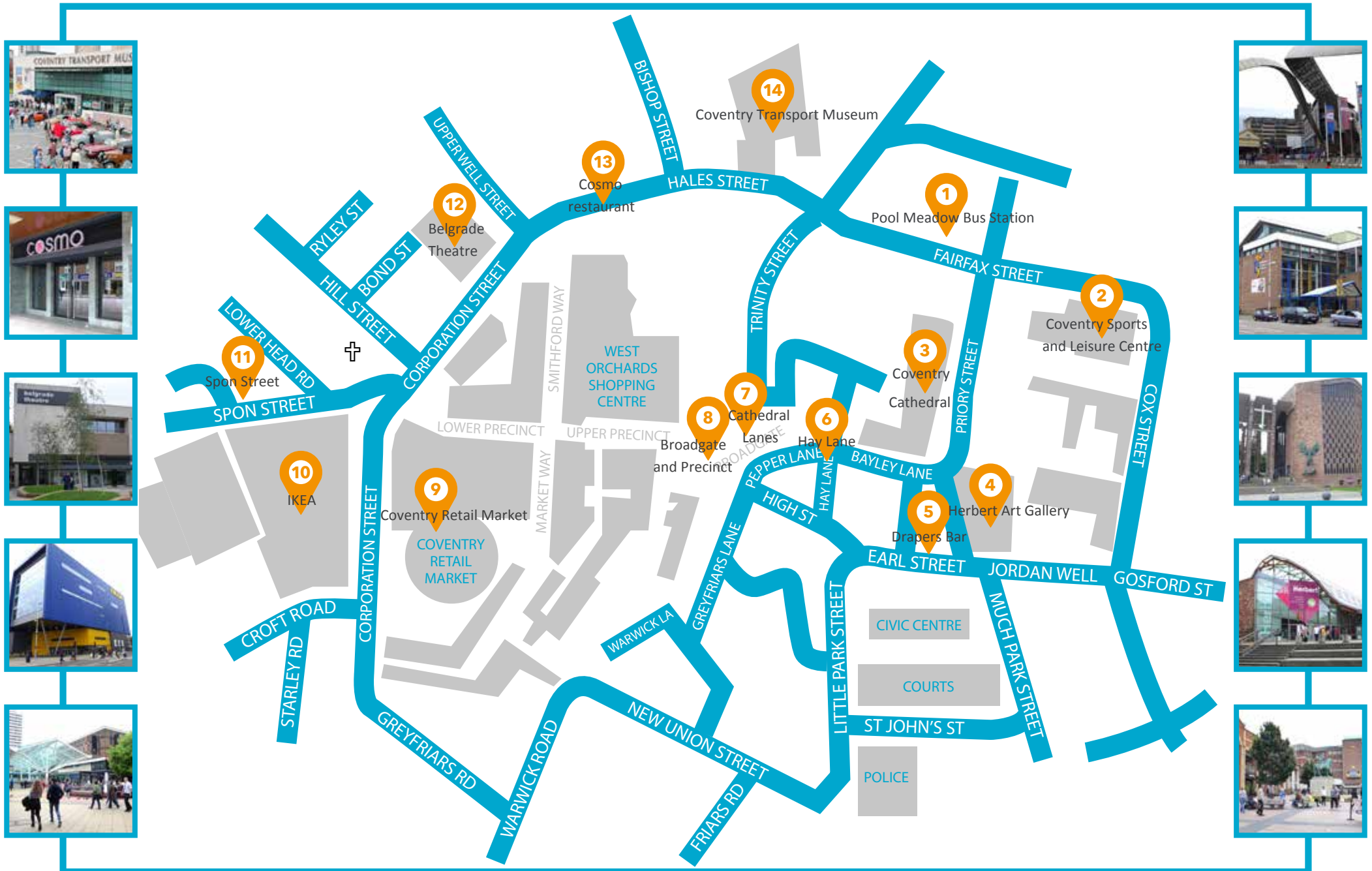

1. Pool Meadow Bus Station

Pool Meadow Bus Station is located in Coventry City centre. Local bus and national coach services operated by various companies serve the bus station.

2. Coventry Sports and Leisure Centre

Lots on offer including a 50 metre Olympic pool.

5. Drapers Bar

An independent bar, Drapers is not your usual bar. You'll find new artists exhibiting their work, regular 'flea markets' where you can find vintage clothing and cheap books, and a reasonably priced full English breakfast.

9. Coventry Market
